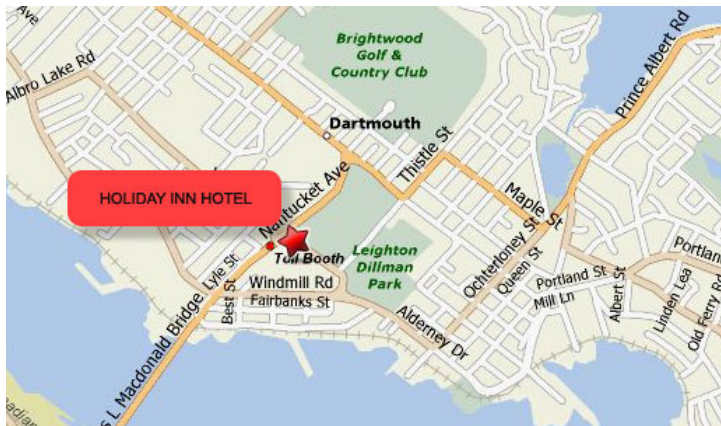
Conference Participants
